FERNLEY

Location: Fernley is located 30 miles East of Reno just off Interstate 80.

Elevation: 4,153 ft

Geography: Fernley is in the high desert of Northern Nevada just off Interstate 80. We are surrounded by beautiful mountains.

Geology: Unknown.

Temperature: January average temperatures are 46°/21° and precipitation is .59". In July the average temperatures are 92°/55° and precipitation is .36".

Climate: Fernley has warm summers and mild winters.

Population: 19,565

History: Both the 1904 Fernley railroad spur and the water canal from the Newlands Project in 1906 were instrumental to Fernley's beginnings. Fernley has developed from a small canal township to an ever-growing City without losing the charm of western living.
